

CURRENT CHARITY WORK

EMPLOYEMENT FOR SLUM WOMEN

Cantabae Education & Welfare Society aims towards the upliftment of the socio-economically backward population in the slums by providing them training for formal employment. Its main focus is to empower the underprivileged living in the slum, particularly women and girls, by inculcating the requisite skills in them and generating employment opportunities.

The initiatives have been taken in and around cities like Bhopal, Indore and Mumbai to motivate these deprived women and provide them a fair chance at white-collar jobs through formal training in soft skills, basic management and sales, computers and English proficiency.

Till date the initiative has successfully trained and placed more than 170 women.

SHELTER & SANITATION FACILITY FOR SLUM WOMEN

Extreme weather events have become perceptibly more frequent in recent years. Floods are becoming common in metros and even in smaller cities, due to unplanned urbanisation and encroachments that destroy cities' natural drainage system.

Cantabae Education & Welfare Society is one such Organisation which has tirelessly been providing relief and shelter to the poor and down trodden specially in Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra and Chhattisgarh..


Till date provision of shelter & hygienic sanitation for slum women has been carried out in cities like Bhopal, Seoni, Ashta, Sehore, Jabalpur, Ujjain, Betul, Chindwada & Harda covering more than 1000+ families.

EDUCATION FOR UNDERPRIVILEGED CHILDREN

Cantabae Education & Welfare Society has been constantly trying to improve learning outcomes of poor and underprivileged children in slums. These children suffer from extreme disparity and deprivation and are engaged in rag picking, waste picking or other small jobs. These children are not attending school regularly and are likely to drop out of school..

Remedial teaching centres have been opened in few locations to impart grade specific education to slum children.

Moreover, providing training & employment initiatives to women also helped them to send children to school.



TEACHING & TRAINING IN ORPHANAGE

Through, Cantabae Education & Welfare Society, children at the orphanages are given teaching & training knowledge so that they may avoid poverty themselves. As they reach 10th grade they have their exams and graduate. The result of this determines if and what a person will continue studying. Some attend technical schools and some college. As the children reach age 18 they move out of the orphanages.

Today many of these children work as doctors, nurses, teachers, lawyers, engineers, and pastors. Some are in the army; others work with IT or run businesses themselves.

SUPPORTING OLD AGE HOMES

Cantabae Education & Welfare Society support senior citizens for their nutrition, shelter, medical and ensuring physical, mental, spiritual and emotional well-being of senior citizen's.

In order to bring a smile on their face and make them feel like a family, Cantabae Education & Welfare Society makes it a point to celebrate festivals with them to create a family like atmosphere among the residents. Senior citizens experience a friendship when they share their joys and sorrows with the team.

GIRL CHILD TRAFFICKING

Trafficking of women and girls for sexual exploitation continues to be a significant issue in India, a crime that denies millions of women and girls their basic rights to liberty and education, and causes serious health problems.

Started with a mission to end sex trafficking, Cantabae Education & Welfare Society works on the issue of sex trafficking and sex crime.
